

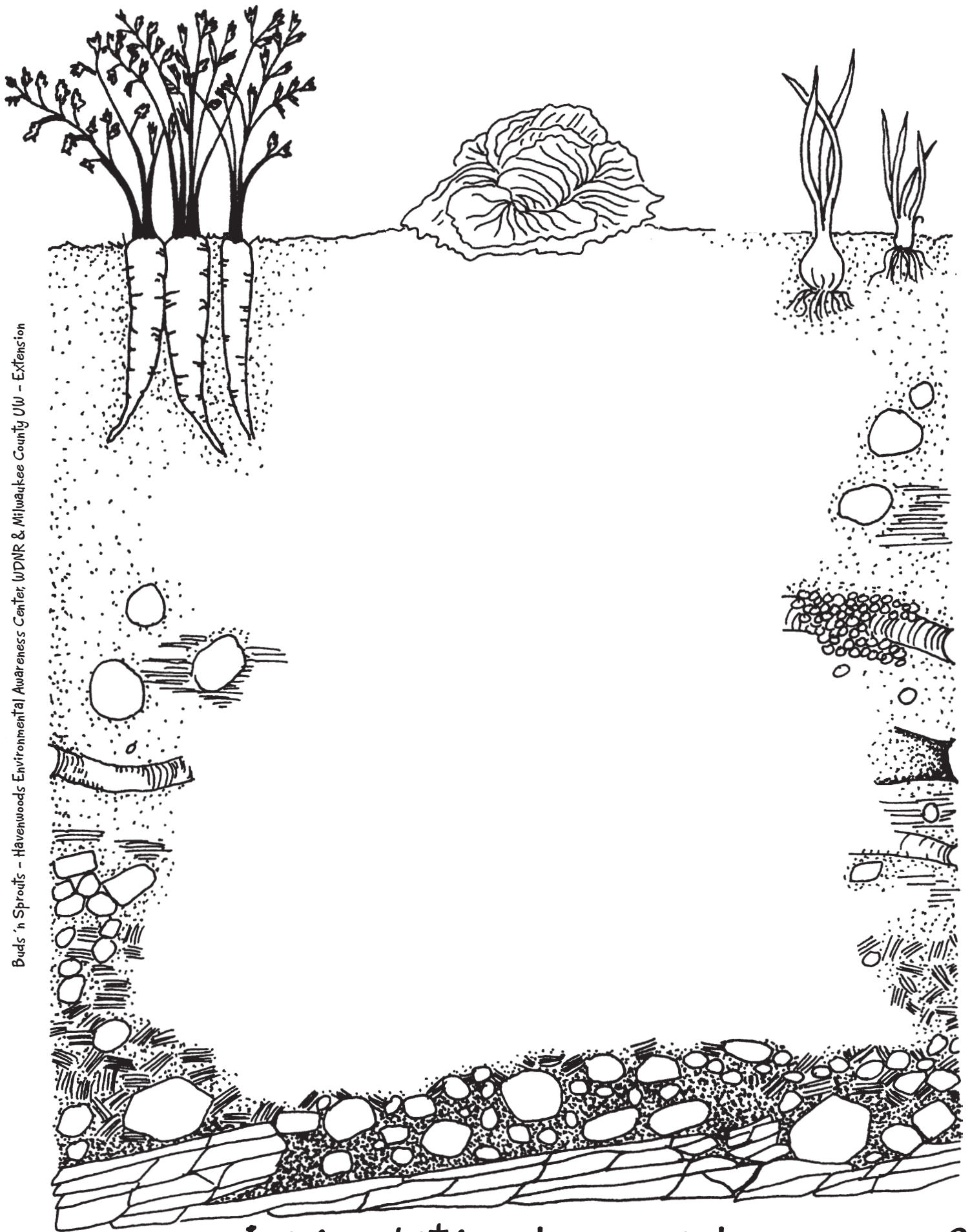

Imagine what is under your garden.

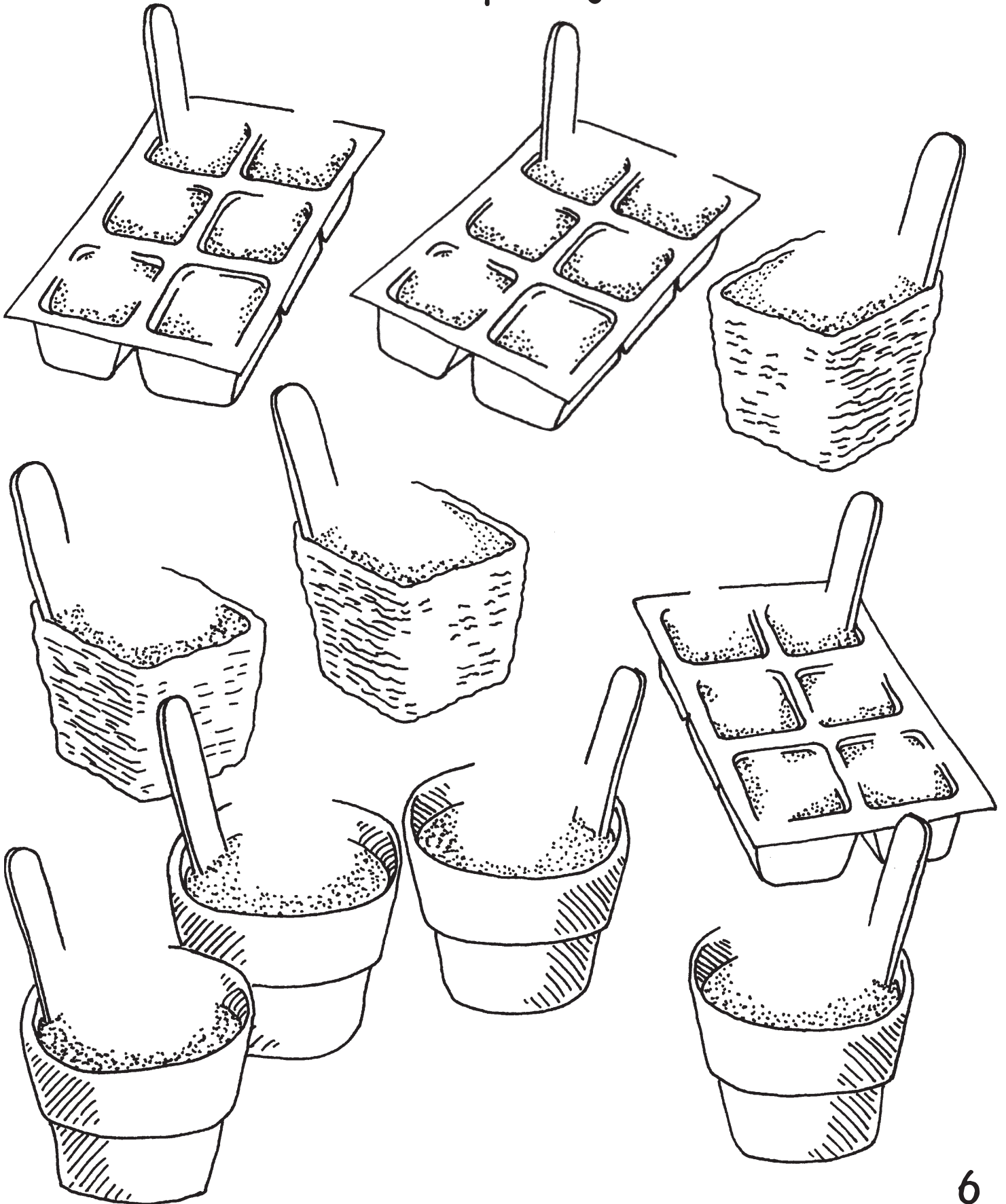


Seeds have been coming in packets for a long time. Design a new packet for a vegetable you like. How will you make people want to buy your seeds?

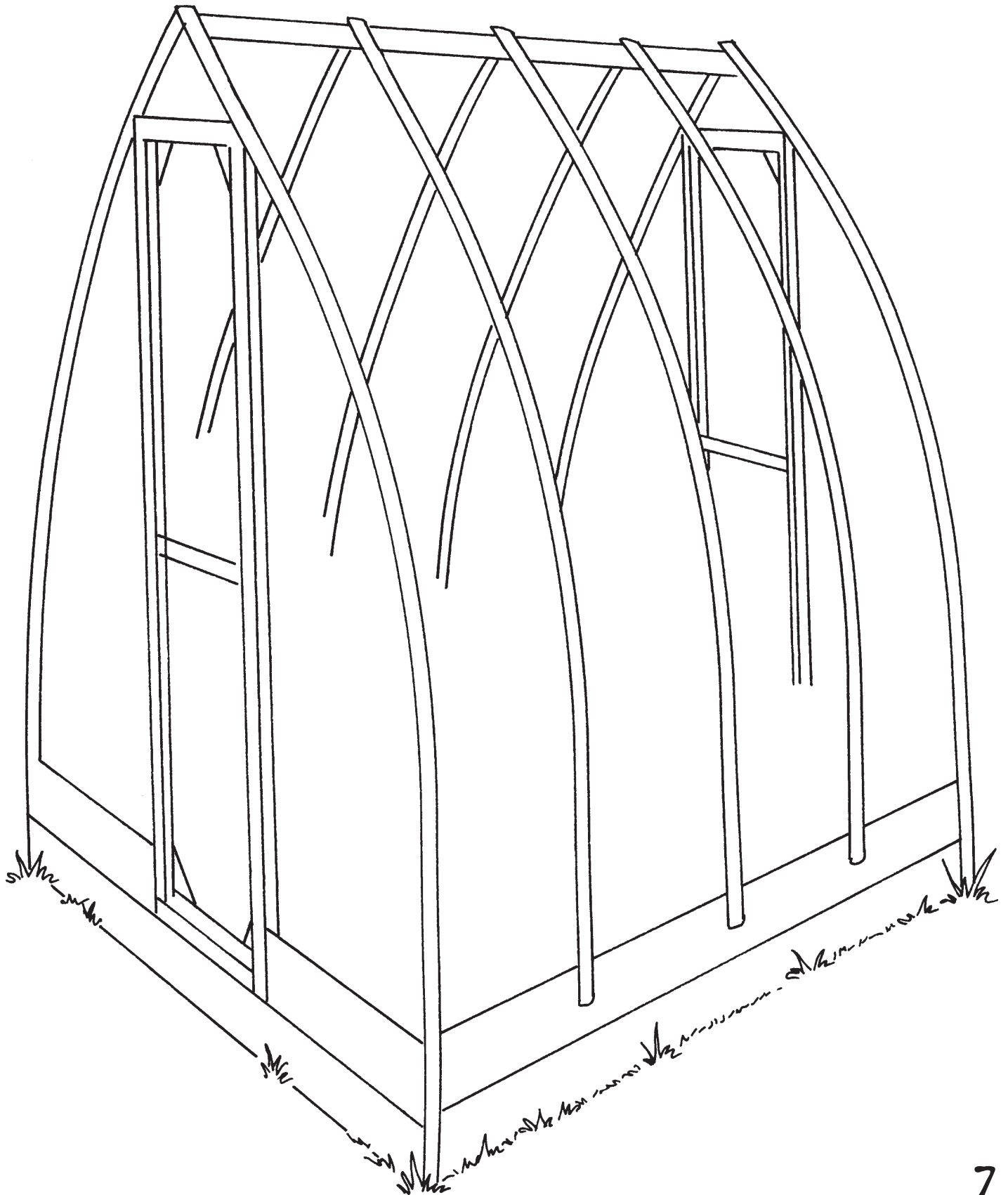


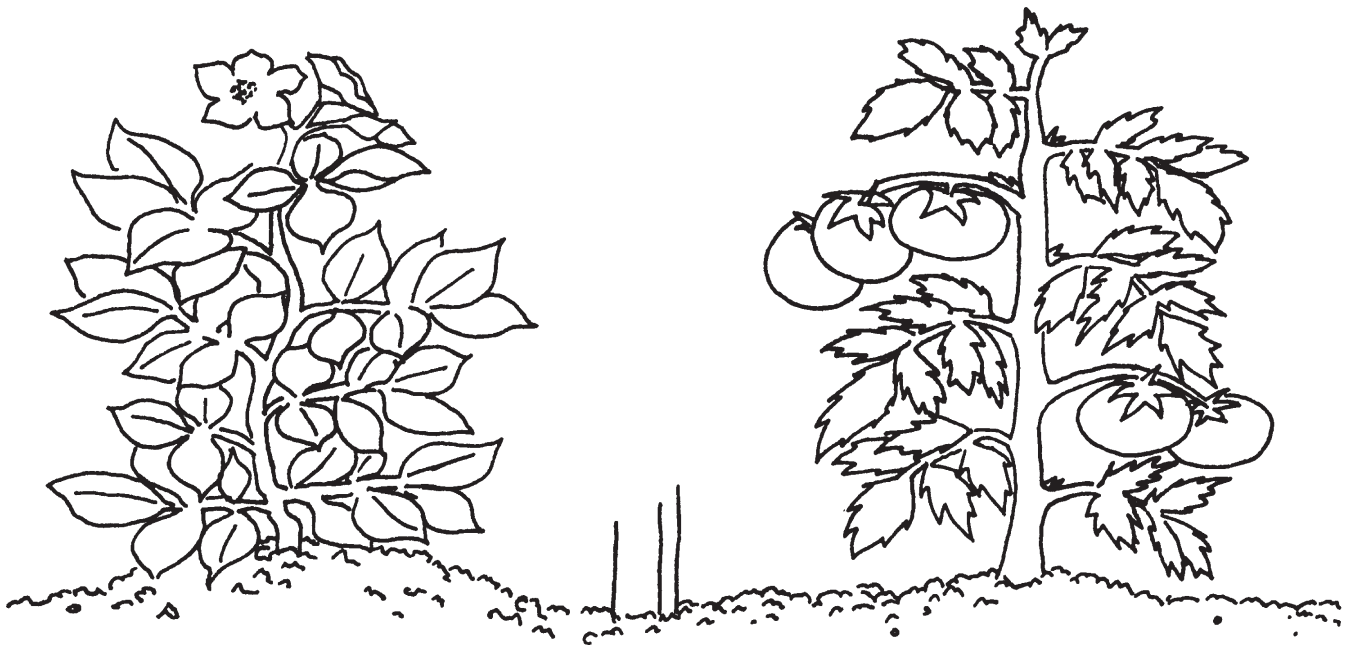
What kind of crazy seeds are These?

what would you grow?





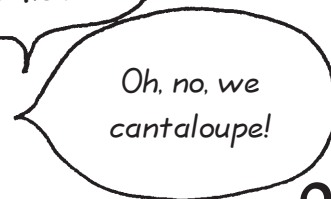
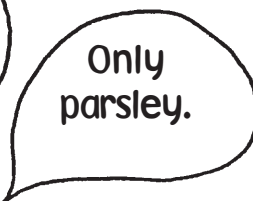

# What happens in your garden at night?



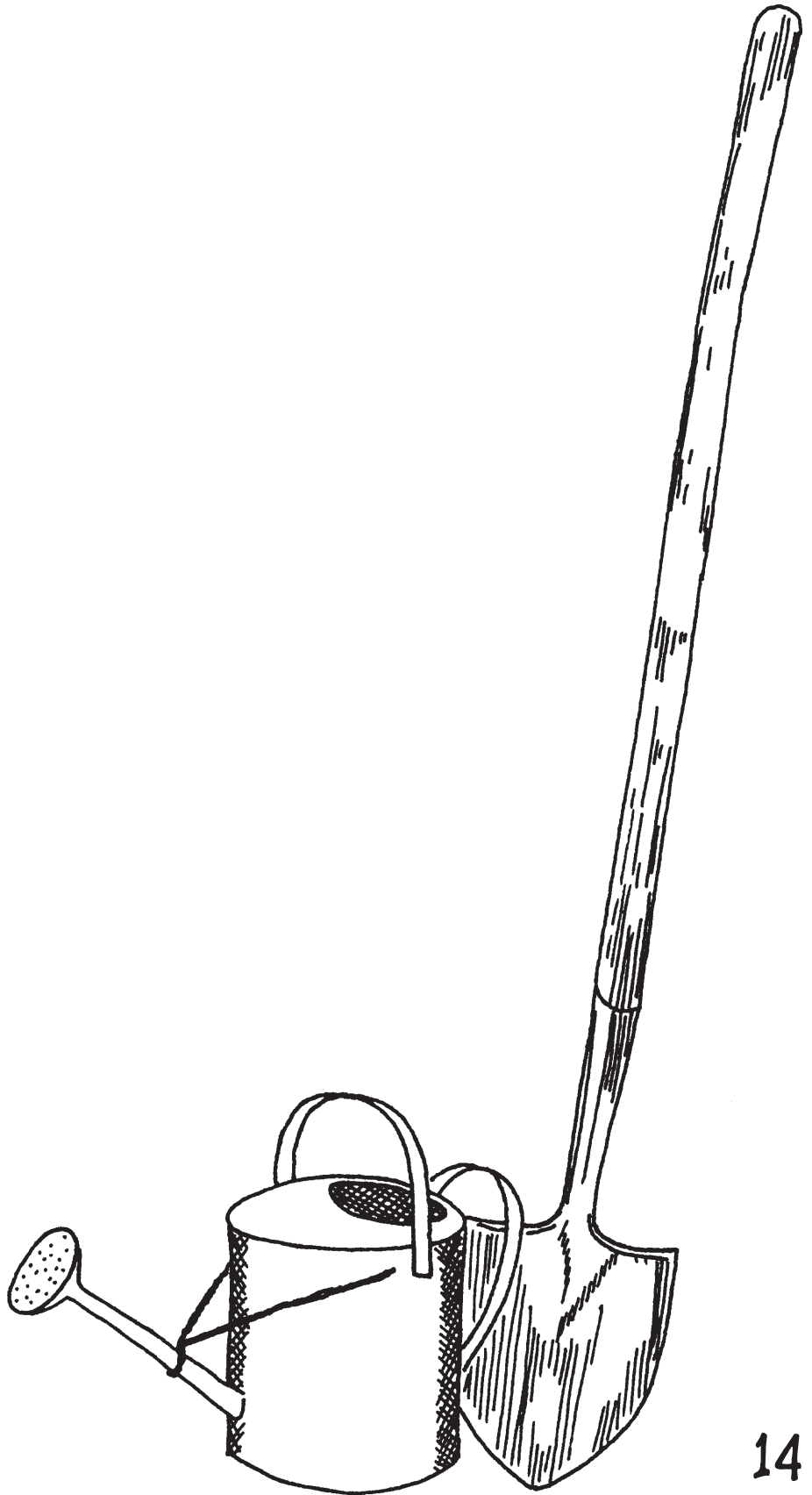
Ordinary garden veggies give us one kind of food

Describe it and draw a picture of it.



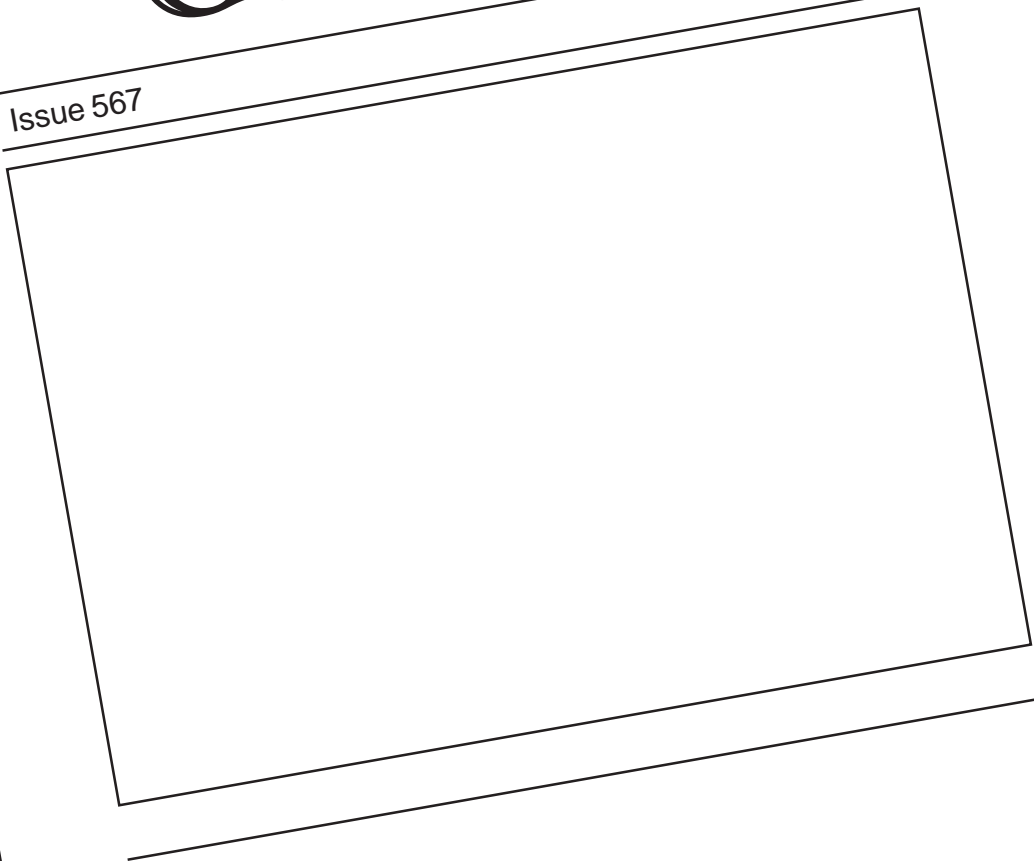
